## STUDENT PROFILE

Instructions to students planning to student teach:

The placement coordinator will send your resume and this **student profile** to the prospective schools when requesting a student teaching placement. The resume includes basic factual information, this **student profile** showcases your personality.

In an interview, the first question is frequently "Tell me a little about yourself." This **student profile** answers that question, and gives you the opportunity to share your enthusiasm for teaching and eagerness to begin student teaching. Be conversational, yet professional like you were talking to a prospective cooperating teacher or principal.

- A) The profile must be typed, double spaced, font size 12, maximum length 2 pages.
- B) Use the same heading as in your resume which includes your name, address, phone number and email.
- C) Use spell check and PROOFREAD to make sure spelling and grammar are flawless.

Following are suggestions for possible topics to include:

- 1. Why do you want to be a teacher? Was there someone (a role model) who inspired you? Was there a moment when you knew teaching was for you?
- 2. During your field experiences or other teaching experiences was there a light-bulb moment when you were able to make a difference in a student's learning or when you were inspired by a student?
- 3. Show your excitement to begin student teaching.
- 4. End with a statement of your teaching philosophy (e.g. "One day I hope to be the kind of teacher who..."). Or you could end with a favorite education/teacher quote.
