	Submitting accurate and complete required forms for application to student teach the year prior to the expected student teaching semester. (See the "Student Teaching" section of the Education Department website for deadline dates.)
	Submitting, in a timely manner, completed required paperwork for recommendation for a Missouri State Teaching Certificate. This includes: an application form (to be completed online through the DESE website), the content area assessment (Praxis), and necessary final official transcripts sent to DESE. (Columbia College must have official transcript from all colleges/universities attended.) No application recommendation for certification will be processed until all materials arrive.
